INSURANCE

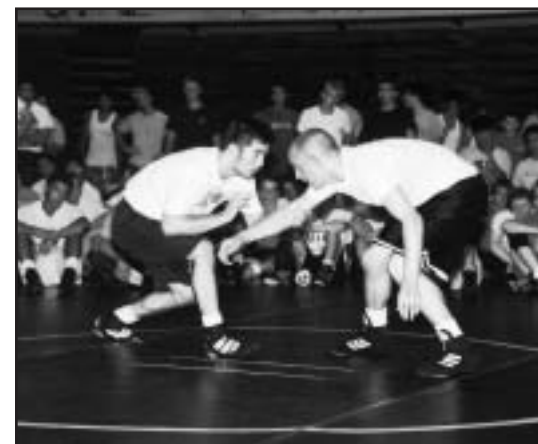
