

Club Championships Rules and Regulations (State Championships)

PURPOSE: The Club Championship is a program designed to recognize individual clubs that compete in California USAW State Championships. The spirit of the Club Championship awards is for individual clubs and athletes registered in that club and not the combining of clubs or the recruiting of athletes, certified coaches, and officials to win the award.

1. Must be a registered USAW Chartered Club *postmarked* seven days prior to the tournament date.
2. Must submit a Club Roster *postmarked* SEVEN DAYS PRIOR TO THE SPECIFIC CHAMPIONSHIP. No changes or deletions may be made after submission of the form.
3. Must have the following ratio of registered USWOA Mat Officials or Pairing Officials working the entire tournament:
 - a. Working the tournaments means not coaching and working at the same time.
 - b. Ratio: 15 or fewer athletes = one Official (one Mat or one Pairer)
 - c. Ratio: 16 or more athletes = two Officials in any combination; i.e., two Pairers, two Mat, or a combination of the two.
 - d. Team awards given: Freestyle and Greco Roman 9-10 (Midget) / 11-12 (Novice) / 13-14 (Schoolboy) / 15-16 (Cadet) / Junior (HS grades 9 through 12) / FILA Jr. / Open.
4. Must have one Club Coach with a minimum of Copper level certification and current USAW registered coach.
5. One Team Award will be given to the first place team in each age group and style.
6. TEAM POINTS: Winners will be determined by a point system using medal placing. Highest place winner per team scores. Only one team member can score per weight.

NOTE: In order to coach in the corner, a floor pass is required. To obtain a floor pass, a coach must have a current USAW Coaches Card and a minimum of a Copper Certification. All floor passes must be worn at all times when on the floor.



CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP ROSTER FORM

If your club wishes to compete in the CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP category, this form must be postmarked seven days prior to the date of the specific event. No change, additions, or deletions may be made after submitting the form.

A wrestler must be a part of the club and must work out with the club on a regular basis prior to the tournament and must be living in the area where the club holds its regular practice sessions.

If this rule is violated, the club may be sanctioned from further participation in this type of competition.
